#### General terms & conditions:

- The appointment of all categories of staff would be made initially for one year and extended by specific orders for such period as may be necessary, but not exceeding one year at a time.
- Appointment will be of temporary and contractual nature for a maximum period of the duration of the study.
- The personnel will have no claim for regular/permanent appointment under the Research Councils / Ministry of AYUSH or the Grantee Institution on completion of the period of appointment.
- Dearness Allowance (DA) and City Compensatory Allowance (CCA) are not admissible.
- HRA will be allowed as per the rules of the Institutions. For this purpose, the fellowship amounts will be taken as basic pay.
- Leave, salary and other service benefits: JRFs, SRFs will continue to be eligible for the Casual Leave. However, Maternity Leave will be given to female staff as per rule of Govt. of India.
- Bonus, L.T.C and Retirement benefits are not admissible to SRF/JRF/non-scientific staff employed for the study.
