The tenders shall be submitted under **two-bid system** as detailed below:

Envelope-A (Technical Bid): Quotation mentioning all technical details of the instrument under sealed envelope should contain following documents:

- Valid and upto date VAT clearance certificate, TIN number, PAN number and other relevant documents.
- Rs. 15000/- in the shape of demand draft/CDR favouring Principal Investigator, Timberline Project, Department of Botany, University of Kashmir, Srinagar.
- Technical literature about the instrument

Envelope-B (Price Bid): It should contain price bid under sealed cover. The price bid should include:

- Bid prices in Indian Rupees
- All duties, taxes, levies (CST/GST/VAT or other taxes) payable must be quoted separately.
- The rates quoted should be FOR Department of Botany, University of Kashmir, Hazratbal, Srinagar.
- The rates quoted should be covered with transparent tape.
- Bid price should be without over-writing/corrections.
